This document explains how you can use Mozilla Firefox to import or export an existing CPAC/Email certificate.


Exporting your certificate from Mozilla Firefox

- 1. Click the hamburger/'Open Menu' button at the top-right corner then select 'Options'
- 2. Select 'Advanced' from the menu on the left

- 4. On the '**Your Certificates**' tab (of the 'Certificate Manager' dialog box), select the certificate you wish to back up and click '**Backup**'

- 6. Next, create a password to protect the PKCS12. This password will be requested should you later import the certificate into another browser/mail client or device.

7. Click **'OK'** to finalize and that's it! You have successfully exported your Comodo Personal Authentication certificate.






Importing your Certificate into Firefox:

- 1. Click the hamburger/'Open Menu' button at the top-right corner then select 'Options'
- 2. Select 'Advanced' from the menu on the left

Optional - Leave enabled 'Ask me every time' under 'When a server requests my personal certificate'.

Doing so alerts you to the fact that a server has requested identity confirmation and enables you to select your Comodo Personal Authentication Certificate.


